

Competition	Fourball Betterball stableford (14 holes)
Eligibility:	Male and female Full Members; Male and female Juniors
Format:	The format is Fourball Betterball stableford. The best stableford score on each hole is selected.
No. of Holes	14 (To enable more teams to play it is competed over 14 holes only). Add nett pars to the scorecard and computer for the last four holes.
Tees:	Men will play off the Winter Yellow tees, and women off the Winter Red tees.
Handicap Limit:	Male and female Members: Handicap Index of 54. Juniors with Course Handicap of 28 or less are eligible to play.
Handicap Allowance:	Playing Handicap is 85% of each players Course Handicap. In addition, women receive 2 courtesy shots added to their Playing Handicap to reflect the different Course Ratings from the men's and women's tees. Include Course Handicap and Playing Handicap for both players on the card. Playing Allowance tables are available by the 1 st tee, in the locker rooms and in the Pro's Shop, and also available using these links: Mens Handicap Allowances and Womens Handicap Allowances
Handicap Qualifying Competition:	No
Entry Fee:	£2 per person Entry Fee . Optional £1 Twos club is available.
Prizes:	Winner is the team with the most stableford points. Prizes will be awarded to the leading teams, and will be available as vouchers from the Pro's shop. In the event of a tie, prizes are awarded based on the best back 5, then 3 holes.
