

<b>Competition</b>	<b>Mens Captain's Drive in Texas Scramble 23rd October 2022</b>
Eligibility:	Male Full Weekend Members and Juniors For teams of four (or optionally three)
Format:	The format is Texas Scramble Strokeplay. Each player plays from the tee on each hole, one of the tee shots is selected and all the players play their second shots from that spot. One of the second shots is then selected, and all players play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed. Teams are made up of 4 people, and can exceptionally be made up of 3 players. Enter the scores in the column of the person whose drive was selected on each hole: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In a team of four, each player must have at least four drives selected.</li> <li>• In a team of three, each player must have at least five drives selected.</li> </ul> Off the green, each player's ball must be dropped within 12 inches of the selected shot. On the green, the ball must be played from the same spot.
No. of Holes	18
Tees:	Men will play off the Winter Orange (Yellow) tees
Handicap Limit:	Handicap Index of 54. Juniors with Course Handicap of 28 or less are eligible to play.
Handicap Allowance:	<b>The team allowance will be calculated by Club V1 when you sign in and printed on your label.</b> Overall Team Allowance is calculated as the aggregate of: 25% of the lowest Course Handicap; 20% of second lowest; 15% of third lowest; and 10% of the highest. For teams of three: 30%, 20%; 10%. Note that final results are calculated using the exact handicap (eg 10.25), although the labels and results sheets round the handicap to the nearest whole number (eg 10). If still tied then the best score on the back 9, then 6, then 3, then 1 will be used.
Handicap Qualifying Competition:	No
Entry Fee:	£8.00 (per person) Entry Fee was paid when booking. This covers: competition entry; prize money, bacon sandwich and charitable contribution to <a href="http://feedingfamilies.org.uk">feedingfamilies.org.uk</a> .
Prizes:	Winner is the team with the lowest number of strokes. Prizes will be awarded to the leading teams, will be available as vouchers from the Pro's shop, and will be announced after the Drive in.
Additional Info	Players must sign-in their teams on the terminals before teeing off, and return scores after their round, using the terminals in either the Pro's Shop or the Trolley Shed. All teams need to be at their tee for the start of play at 9:15, when the Klaxon will be sounded. All completed scorecards must be signed by at least one team player and returned into the box in the Clubhouse. Teams must email the competitions team or tell the Pro's Shop if any of the teams change. Bacon sandwiches will be available in the clubhouse after the round. The Captain will drive off from the 1 <sup>st</sup> tee at around 2pm. Prizes will be awarded in the clubhouse shortly afterwards. In Winter Teams competitions, which do not count for handicap, the non-qualifying winter rules apply: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Preferred Lies will be available on both the fairways and semi-rough.</li> <li>• Preferred Lies are not in operation in the long rough or plantations.</li> <li>• Rake and replace is available in the bunkers.</li> <li>• Mats can be used on the fairway and semi rough.</li> </ul> Full rules are available in locker room and City website: <a href="#">Winter Rules: Non-Qualifying</a> The Pro's Shop will help you with sign in, score return or any questions, or you can email the competition team at: <a href="mailto:competitions@cityofnewcastlegolfclub.com">competitions@cityofnewcastlegolfclub.com</a> .
