

<b>Competition</b>	<b>The Olivers Trophies</b>
Eligibility:	Male Full Members; Male Juniors
Format:	The Olivers is a fourball better ball bogey event which is normally played on the first Sunday of each winter season month. A Bogey event is matchplay against par (a nett birdie wins the hole, a nett par halves the hole, and a net bogey or worse is a loss)
No. of Holes	18
Tees:	Either Men's Yellow or Orange tees depending on the tees in play.
Handicap Limit:	Male Members: Handicap Index of 54. Juniors with Course Handicap of 28 or less are eligible to play.
Handicap Allowance:	Playing Handicap is 90% of Course Handicap for each player. Include Course Handicap and Playing Handicap for both players on the card. Handicap Allowance tables are available in the Pro's shop, locker room wall, in the locker room and on the website: <a href="#">handicap tables</a>
Handicap Qualifying Competition:	No
Entry Fee:	£2.00 (per person) Entry Fee ; There is an optional £1 Twos entry
Prizes:	The winning team of each qualifying round will be presented with a commemorative plaque at the Trophy Presentation evening the following November. The team with the winning score, and ties from each qualifying round will be entered into the Olivers Finals which will be played at the end of March with the winners of the Final presented with the Olivers Trophies, a commemorative plaque and names on Honours Board. (If the team, or one of the players, with the leading score have already qualified, then the team(s) with the next best score qualify for the final) Monthly prizes will be awarded by the committee as vouchers available to spend in the Pro's shop.
Additional Info	If any holes are closed then teams should enter a nett par (for a half) on those holes. Non -Qualifying rules are in operation for teams competitions. Full details are available on the locker room noticeboard: <a href="#">Non Qualifying rules</a> Players will Sign in to the competition and return scores using the terminals. All completed scorecards must be signed by marker and player and returned into the box in the clubhouse.
